At Berkeley, he taught comparative law, conflict of laws, and comparative jurisprudence with Professors Albert EHRENZWIEG, Stan RIESENFIELD and Richard BUXBAUM; being also a specialist of transnational and comparative economic law which he has been teaching at Cairo University, the Institut de Droit des Affaires, and Ein Shams University Law Schools at graduate level.

33 years ago, he was appointed Senior Deputy Attorney General in Cairo, few years later he became International and U.S. Counsel for IBM in New York and afterwards for IBM Europe.

Till today, Prof. ELGHATIT is a member of EGYPT's Presidential Specialized Advisory Council. Professor ELGHATIT is intimately involved in the legislative process of fundamental Acts such as the Fiscal and Economic Legislation Egyptian Tax Law, the Companies Law, and the International Arbitration Law for Egypt in 1994 and 1997.

Moreover, his broad range of activities included a membership in the standing Committee on Arab Comparative and Sharia Law as well as Founding Member and Chairman of the Mediterranean and Middle East Institute of Arbitration (Cyprus), regional representative for Arab countries to IBA Business Law Section and IBA committee on International construction Law.
